

Interactive Sourcebook Features Guide

Choosing the Year(s) and Federal Judicial District(s):

The Interactive Sourcebook provides the user the ability to produce tables and figures for a particular sentencing year or set of years as well as for a particular federal judicial circuit or judicial district. Currently, the Interactive Sourcebook allows the user to generate tables and figures using data for fiscal years 2006-2012. To select the table or figure of interest, first go to the Table of Contents and click on the + sign next to the section headings to access the list of tables and figures available in the section of interest.

For example, if the topic of interest is demographic information such as race, gender and age of offenders, select “Age, Race, and Gender of Offenders” which is Table 7 in the Commission’s *Sourcebook*.





A pop-up box will appear with a list of the fiscal years of data available along with a list of the federal circuits and districts. Note that the Interactive Sourcebook has a default setting that will always show data at the ***national level*** (i.e., all districts) for the ***most recent*** fiscal year data available.

To change the fiscal year of data, unselect the most recent fiscal year, then select the fiscal year or years of data by clicking the appropriate boxes. If more than one year is selected, the data from all the selected years ***will be aggregated***. To create a table or figure with data that is **NOT** aggregated, generate a separate table or figure for each year of interest. Creating a separate table or figure for each year will allow comparison of data over time.



Next, in the same pop-up selection box, the user can limit the information generated to a particular judicial circuit or district. The Interactive Sourcebook defaults to the “Circuit” option, however, by simply clicking on the circle next to the term “District,” the district selections will become available. Users **cannot** choose both circuit **and** district options, however, users **can** choose multiple circuits **or** multiple districts (e.g., users can choose Alabama Middle, Alabama North, and Alabama South to make a table of all of the judicial districts in the state of Alabama).



After making the selections, click “Apply” in the upper right-hand portion of the pop-up box.





Sorting the Data:

The Interactive Sourcebook allows a user to sort data with specificity. For example, all of the tables by primary offense type default to the primary offense type order set forth in the Commission's *Sourcebooks*. The "sort function" enables users to sort information by the column of your choice (e.g., total number of cases).

To sort the table, select the column of interest and click the up/down arrows next to that column heading. The sort options are "Natural Order", "Ascending Order", and "Descending Order." The Interactive Sourcebook default is "Natural Order," but that can be changed to either "Ascending Order" or "Descending Order" by clicking on the up/down arrow.

The first time the up/down arrows are selected, the sort will change from Natural sort order to Ascending. If you are sorting on a district with Circuits and Districts (Ex. Table 2), the sort removes the hierarchy of the circuits and the state aggregations so that only districts will appear in the sorted table.




